INFORMATION REQUIRED FOR GENERAL ASSISTANCE FUNDING

Please provide us with the following for everyone in the household:

- Proof of Income for the last 30 days (Pay stubs, Social Security Statements, employer's written statement, Works Comp Statements, Child Support, Foster Care Income, FIP, Veterans Benefits, etc.).
 - If you cannot work, a current doctor's statement.
 - If you have had no income in the last 30 days you must obtain a White Sheet from Iowa Workforce Development, located at 200 Army Post Road, Des Moines, IA 50315. Phone: 515-281-9619.
- Documentation of how you have spent your money in the past 30 days (from date of application). Last 30 days of transactions, all checking/savings/online bank accounts for anyone in your household.
- For Rental Assistance: Copy of your lease or rental agreement.
 - Completed Landlord Verification Form (filled by the landlord or manager).
- For Utility Assistance: Copy of your utility bill and disconnect notice.
- □ If you are a Veteran, you must have a letter from the Veteran's Affairs office stating you are not eligible for benefits through them. Their address is 105 West First Avenue, Indianola, IA 50125. Phone: 515-961-1045.
 - *We must have all required information before we are able to assist you. If it is found out that you have provided false information, to receive benefits, you will not be eligible for assistance from our office for three (3) years from the date you applied.
 - *Please note that Warren County General Assistance is no longer accepting documents via email. In person signatures are needed for application to be approved.

Qualifications for General Assistance Funding

- ☐ Income Eligibility Criteria:
 - 125% Gross Income = \$1,416 One Person Household (\$492 each additional family member). Subject to change at request of the Warren County Board of Supervisors
- For Utility Assistance:
 - o Must have made "good faith" effort payment(s) during the moratorium (Nov. March).
- □ For Rental Assistance:
 - o Must be renting, and not receiving assistance via Section 8 or HUD.
